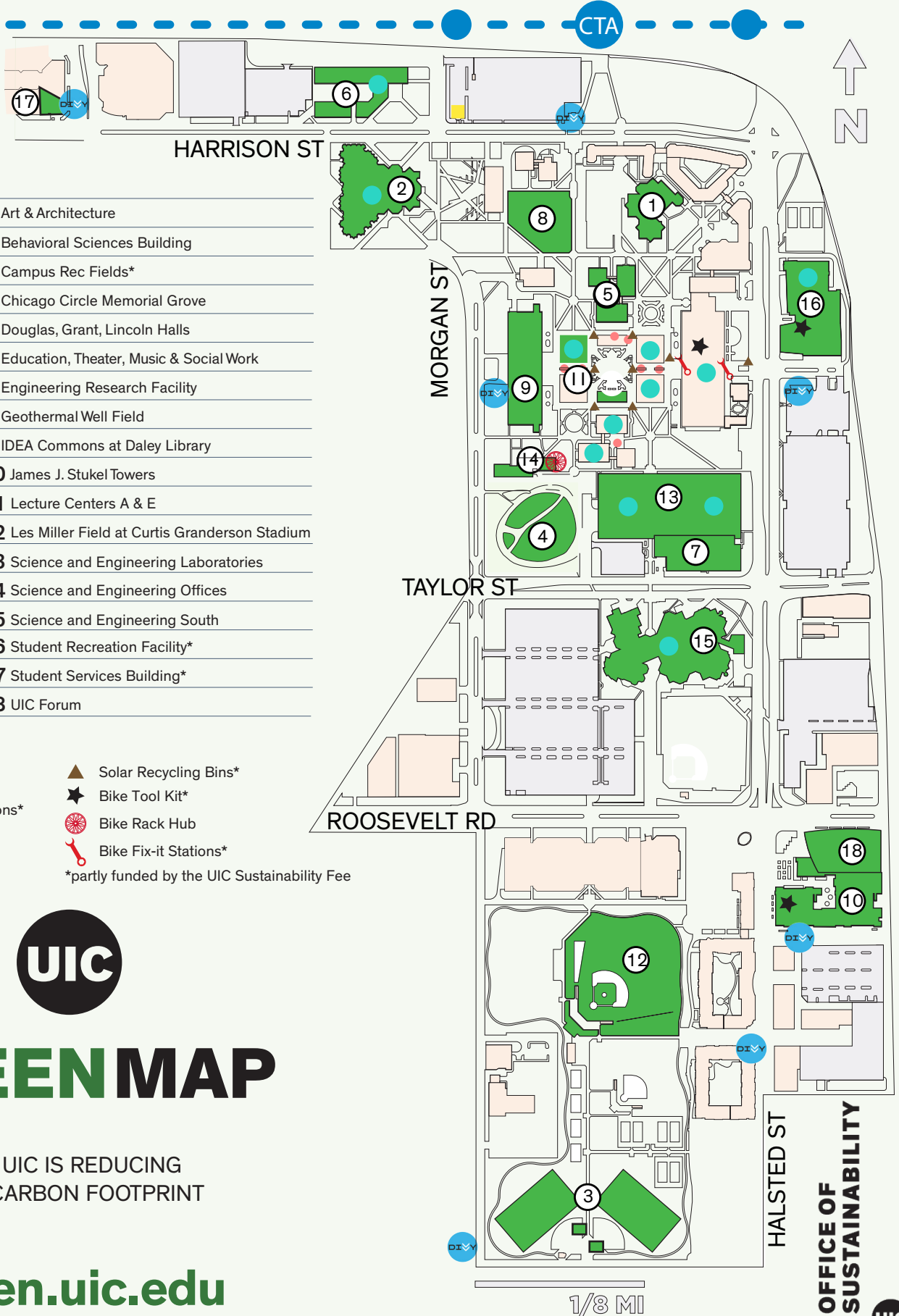

Recycling

The goal of the UIC Recycling Program is to get to zero waste. UIC has a recycling rate of over 45% and we aim to increase that by **reducing** the waste we produce by choosing materials wisely; **reusing** what we have already by considering new roles for unwanted material; and **recycling** what must be thrown away, thus minimizing material bound for the landfill.



How UIC Recycles

Recycling Stations can be found in every building at UIC. These stations usually consist of three bins (Paper; Glass, Metal & Plastic; and Landfill). UIC also strives to reduce waste at the source - so bring a refillable water bottle. UIC has multiple triple filtered water bottle refill stations on campus!

Recycling Stations Guide



Glass, Metal, Plastic

Acceptable Materials

- Aluminum Cans
- Steel Cans
- Plastic Bottles (numbers 1 to 5, and 7)
- Glass Bottles
- Aluminum Foil
- Juice Boxes and Tetra Paks
- Non-hazardous, empty chemical bottles etc.



Landfill

Whatever cannot be recycled must go to the landfill including

- #6 Polystyrene (i.e. Styrofoam Cups and Packing)
- Broken Glass
- Plastic Cutlery
- Non-compostable plates and food wrappers
- Paper cups lined with plastic or wax etc.



Paper

Acceptable Papers

- White and Colored Paper
- Glossy Paper
- Envelopes
- Newspapers & Magazines
- Copy-Paper Ream Wrappers
- Post-it Notes
- Chip board (e.g. tissue boxes)
- Brown Paper
- Hard-Bound Books
- Milk Cartons etc.



UIC is Bike Friendly

UIC is recognized nationally as a Bike Friendly University, and UIC's location puts it well within the city's large bike infrastructure. It's easy to get to UIC by bike!

If you find yourself with low tire pressure, stop by to borrow a Bike Pump, Repair Kit, or Use a Fix-It Station! The tool-kits and the repair stations can be found outside both of the Student Centers, while the tool-kits can be checked out at the Student Recreation Facility, Student Housing, or at either Student Center.

Bring your helmet to any UIC Recreation Center, and you get 30 minutes to clean up in the locker room!

Bike Racks

There are over 800 outdoor bike racks at UIC, including a large, covered bike hub, so you can find a place close to your class to park your bike.



Divvy

Divvy is Chicago's bike sharing system with 4,760 bikes and 476 stations across the city.

A Divvy Membership is only \$55 a year for UIC students!
